Please note that the Ministry Visit was not our schools official opening. The official opening is being planned for a later date and messaging with an invite to the community will come out in a separate communication.

School Supplies:

School supply lists were sent out by teachers with their Welcome letter. Please let your classroom teacher know if you are having trouble finding supplies or need financial assistance. Supply fees have gone out and can be paid via our SchoolCash online system. If you prefer to pay with cash or cheque (to SD68), please clearly label with student's name and it can be dropped off at our office.

Pick up, Drop off, School Phone and Leaving Early

Please do your best to organize plans with your child prior to them coming to school. If you must change plans with your child, please email <u>info.hb@sd68.bc.ca</u> and we will ensure that the message is delivered. A reminder that if you need to pick up your child early, please let the classroom teacher <u>and</u> the office know in advance so that students can be prepared for their departure.

All students should be staying near their pickup/drop off location organized by teacher until their adult picks them up. Duties will bring any students who are not picked up to the office until someone comes to pick them up. Students need to be picked up as soon as possible after school *and should not be heading to park or off site without their adult*. Any child who can not find their adult should report to the nearest duty or come to the office. Thank you.

Change to long recess:

Beginning on Monday September 18th, we will be adjusting our long recess bell to start and end five minutes earlier than it is now. Our new lunch hour will begin at 11:40am and will end at 12:15pm. This small change will have a big impact on our ability to provide your child with continuity in learning throughout the week as well as allowing our staff to more efficiently plan and organize class and school activities.
