Inclement Weather:

Illness:

There is an increase in respiratory illness and flu like symptoms at this time. If your child has had a fever within the past 24 hours, or currently has a bad cough or cold symptoms, please keep them home until the symptoms subside.

Parking:

Please be respectful and safe when picking up and dropping off your child at school. <u>Handicap parking stalls</u> are limited. People with mobility issues that are picking up young children who require hand off (kindergarten/grade 1) should have priority.

Do not park in daycare spots or bus lanes.

Do not block Fire lanes and Fire hydrants.

<u>Shores Drive</u>: The By-Law officers and RCMP will be monitoring parking along Shores Drive as there have been many complaints about unsafe or illegal parking there. Please ensure you are legally parked and are driving safe for our children..

SD68 Registration 2024

Registration Information and timeline for students entering Kindergarten and students transitioning to Highschool in 2024.

<u>Kindergarten registration:</u>

- Opened online Jan 10th at 8am. The link is found through the Registration Tab on the SD68 Website.
- ALL parents must register online as the first step.
- Parents who have an older sibling attending Hammond Bay during the 2024 school year must identify the sibling when registering online <u>AND</u> email this information to info.hb@sd68.bc.ca
- Prior to the French Immersion lottery, Kindergarten siblings that have been identified through our office and through the registration office will be placed in our school.
- Once siblings are placed, the remaining spots will go to lottery.
- Lottery will be held after January 31st-date TBD.
- If you do not register your child online prior to January 31st, you will be waitlisted after the lottery. Please ensure you register.

We look forward to welcoming your child in September.


Grade 7 Transition to highschool:

- All students attending Ecole Hammond Bay in grade 7 will automatically be enrolled into our catchment Highschool NDSS. No need to register online.
- Course selection happens in the Spring. You do not need to apply online to go to NDSS.

PLEASE NOTE: If you wish to register your child in a **secondary academy** or change to an **"Out of catchment Highschool"** (any Highschool other than NDSS) then you DO need to apply online. Here are the steps below:

- Online Registration for **Academies or Out of Catchment schools** opened on Jan 10th at 8am. Please register through the Registration Tab on the SD68 Website.
- Applications for Academies will be received until March 1, 2024, at which time student selection will be determined either by lottery or tryout/audition. Parents will be notified by the Registration office by the end of May 2024. Out-of-catchment applications are due March 31, 2024.
