Solar Eclipse

On Monday, April 8th there will be a solar eclipse. Unlike the 2017 total solar eclipse in Oregon, Nanaimo will only see a 10% partial eclipse next Monday. https://www.timeanddate.com/eclipse/in/canada/vancouver?iso=20240408

For precautions:

- Do not look directly at the sun, the best way to see any part of the eclipse is by making a pin hole camera.
- Even if its cloudy, it should only be directly viewed using proper solar glasses.
- The NASA website will have a live broadcast of the eclipse (maximum eclipse 11:17 am Nanaimo time) and it has a great safety page. <u>https://science.nasa.gov/eclipses/future-eclipses/eclipse-2024/</u>
