Traffic Safety:

We are currently working with the RCMP, the City of Nanaimo and the District to find ways to improve the traffic safety in this area. Staff are talking to students about the importance of staying safe when walking near roads.

We ask you, the parent body, to help us in this collective effort to keep everyone safe by doing the following:

- Stay extra vigilant when driving along Hammond Bay Road, Morningside Drive and in our school parking lot **drive slowly and cautiously.**
- Only drop children off where it is safe to do so. Drop off areas begin at the roundabout and continue along the right side of the parking lot as you exit.
- Please do not <u>park in our round-about nor park in the drop-off only areas</u>. They are designed to keep the flow of traffic steady and allow kids a safe space to exit their vehicles.
- If you are parking along the back of the parking lot (by the woods), please walk along the perimeter of the parking with your child in hand. Do do not walk through our parking lot or allow your child to wander through it alone. This is not safe.
- If you are parking at Neck point, please use the rainbow crosswalk and our paved sidewalks to get onto school grounds.

<u>Parents of students who are taking the bus along Hammond Bay</u> – Please talk to your child about the importance of safety when waiting near the road. The bus stop near Hammond Bay and Morningside Drive is not well marked and is in a busy area. You may wish to advise your child to go to the bus stop a little further up Hammond Bay where there is less traffic.
