*Content Ideas: Lego sets, Lego stickers, Lego-themed cups/bowls/plates/pencils/summer toys, anything with Lego on it etc ...*

### **Grade 3/4 and 4- Div 11/Div 12 - “A Camping We Will Go”**

*Content Ideas: roasting sticks, marshmallows, flash lights, camping chairs, lanterns, BBQ lighters, s’mores ingredients, fishing rods, hiking sticks, insulated mugs, bug spray, cooler bag, etc ...*

### **Grade 4/5 and 5/6- Div 13/Div 14 - “A Little Bit Salty”**

*Content Ideas: peanuts, gourmet crackers, pate, salted caramels, chips, pretzels, popcorn, infused salts, olives, mixed nuts, etc ...*

### **Grade 4/5 and 5/6- Div 15/Div 16 - “Summer Mocktails”**
